Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm, and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation (Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod) are asked to first speak with the Pastor or an usher (for study see Matthew 5:23ff; 10:32ff; 18:15-35; 26:26-29; John 17:20-23; Romans 16:17-18; 1 Corinthians 10:14-22; 1 Corinthians 11:17-34; Acts 2:42-47; the basis of this statement).
